Overview of the Programme

Open Educational Resources (OERs) have emerged as one of the most innovative teaching and learning tools as well as a cost-effective mechanism to improve the quality of educational offerings by optimising the use of available resources.

OERs via e-Learning now offer universities (especially Open Universities) that depend on printed distance learning materials a more economical and expeditious alternative to develop and offer their courses and programmes.

This programme was developed to facilitate this cause and to promote the use of OER in educational institutions. Initially an effort by the The Commonwealth Educational Media Centre for Asia (CEMCA) as part of the institutional capacity building for OER-based eLearning at Wawasan Open University (WOU), faculty members of WOU and several other institutions in Asia have contributed to the development of the contents with the guidance and support of an international group of academics and experts from India, Sri Lanka and Australia.

Learning Outcomes

After completion of all the five modules, the participants will be able to:

1. Demonstrate understanding of OER and argue in support of the use of OER.
2. Use appropriate open license to release educational materials as OER.
3. Search and evaluate the quality of OER materials used in different contexts.
4. Design appropriate learning experiences for OER-based eLearning.
5. Offer OER-based eLearning courses and programmes using appropriate technologies.
